Hair

He's bald.

She's got wavy hair.

Hair can be ...

chin-length

shoulder-length

long

short

It comes in many colours: black, dark brown, light brown, auburn, ginger (= red), strawberry blond, blond, grey, white.

Skin

Skin also comes in many colours: His skin is black / dark / tanned (darker from the sunlight) / white / fair (= light) / pale (light and maybe unhealthy-looking).

Face

She's got a thin face.

He's got a round face.

He's got a beard.

She's got / wears glasses.

He's got a moustache.

She's got freckles.

She's got a snub nose.

She's got a straight nose.

She's got a hooked nose.

She's very thin.

He's slim.

She's a bit overweight.

He's fat (NOT: thick!).

Height and build

He's tall. (NOT: big!)

She's medium height.

He's short.

Sally is easy-going .	She’s relaxed and doesn’t worry.
Sally is lazy .	She doesn’t like working hard. She just wants to sit on her bean bag and watch TV.
